School Community Communications

Communication with the Board is encouraged in several different ways.

- All parents/guardians, staff, and community members are invited to attend the monthly meetings of the Board. These meetings are open, and anyone interested may attend. The agenda for the meetings is posted on the school website at least 4 days before the meeting.
- A period of public comment is included at each Board meeting.
- Letters sharing concerns may be sent to the Board by one of the following methods:
 - Via email to the Board chairperson or a member of the Executive Committee.
 - Via mail addressed to the attention of the Board chairperson at the school.
 - By hand, placed in the Board chairperson's box in the office.

Letters will be read at the next Board meeting. The same procedure is followed for any letter received. Parents/guardians should always feel free to identify themselves if the issue is of a serious nature that requires follow up. Unsigned (anonymous) letters may or may not be presented depending on the appropriateness of the content.

It is the desire of the Board to have open, effective communication with the school community. Families should feel comfortable and not fear retaliation for expressing their concerns. Constructive criticism is always welcome. We ask that persons submitting concerns that call for action be prepared to assist with the solution where possible. We are a Board of parents and community members and will make every effort to address concerns.
